Ram Kumar Phuyal is a member of the National Planning Commission, Government of Nepal (GON) since 26th April 2018. He is an accomplished economist with over 17 years of solid experience in teaching various fields of Economics to Graduate students and conducting evidence-based policy research in Nepal and abroad. His expertise lies on: Development Economics, Industrial Organization, Regulatory Economics, International Trade, Development Planning, Public Policy Analysis, and Applied Policy Research. Before the assignment in NPC, he was a faculty member of Centre for Economic Development and Administration (CEDA), Tribhuvan University (TU), Kirtipur since 2013. Besides, he has also served as an adjunct faculty member in Kathmandu University, Pokhara University, HELP University, and Mid-Western University affiliated top colleges. He has taught to graduate and post-graduate students in quantitative economics, business mathematics & statistics, microeconomics, international economics, development economics, managerial economics, and research methodology. He has supervised dissertation research of over 200 graduate students in these universities.

He holds a Ph.D. in Economics from Chonnam National University (CNU), South Korea, where he was honored with the outstanding Ph.D. fellowship awards in the years 2006 and 2007. Then, he served as a post-doctoral fellow in economics at Centre for Regional Development (CRD) of CNU. He has received the prestigious Nepal Bidya Bhushan Padak-First Class from Government of Nepal.

Earlier, he has served as a senior advisor/expert at various committees and tasks force set up by Government of Nepal, University Grants Commission (UGC) of Nepal, Tribhuvan University, Kathmandu University, and Pokhara University. Besides, Dr. Phuyal has served as a visiting scholar in CRD of Chonnam National University in 2016, Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy of Singapore National University in 2016, and South Asian University, New Delhi in 2015.

During his work at CEDA, Tribhuvan University, he has provided leadership on several applied policy research projects on agriculture, climate change, drinking water, labor markets and employment policies, poverty and inequality assessment, tourism and industries management, and also provided evidence-based policies and recommendations to the policy makers and government officials with informed development policies, plans, and programs. Several of these research projects were supported by Government of Nepal, International Labor Organization (in 2013), UGC/Nepal (in 2014), Water Aid Nepal (in 2015), Practical Action-UK Aid (in 2017) and The World Bank (2016&2018).

Dr. Phuyal has carried out policy research on wider-subject areas, and published over 25 papers in the peer-reviewed indexed journals such as Korean Industrial Economic Association, Japanese Economic Review, Chinese Business Review, Studies in Regional Development, Asian Economic and Financial Review, etc. He has served as a chief editor of peer review journals in economics and has served as an editorial board member in scholarly journals including; Journal of Development and Administrative Studies, World Journal of Social Sciences, and Journal of Business and Social Sciences Research.
